Re: WNYC fundraiser

Dear Ms. Gramling:

On behalf of Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of 34 noncommercial educational radio stations, you seek waiver of Section 73.503(d) of the Commission's rules to permit on-air fundraising to help rebuild the transmission facilities of Station WNYC(FM), New York, New York, which were destroyed in the September 11, 2001 terrorist attack on the World Trade Center. Specifically, MPR proposes to ask listeners for an additional contribution -- strictly designated for WNYC(FM) --during its fall on-air pledge drive from October 18, 2001 through October 30, 2001.

Due to the catastrophic nature of this horrific incident, the limited duration of the proposed fundraising effort, and the fact that it will be incorporated into the scheduled pledge drive permissibly aired on MPR's stations by simply adding disaster relief as another recipient for funds, the Commission concludes that the public interest would be served by grant of the requested waiver for each of the following MPR stations:

Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR")is the licensee of 31 radio stations, primarily in Minnesota, that are all operated on a non-commercial basis. Sixteen of the stations are classical music stations, fourteen are news ϵ

information stations, and one is a combination of news and music. MPR's upcoming fall on-air fundraiser/pledge drive will be a total of 13 days long

- with 10 days of on-air fundraising on our news stations and 8 days of fundraising on the music stations. The drive will begin on October 18, 2001

and end on October 30, 2001.

WELL EL THE

WNYC, a public radio station in New York City, lost its FM transmitter atop

the World Trade Center's North Tower. Details about how the terrorist attack

left them without office and transmitting facilities are detailed on their

website at www.wnyc.org. They continue to operate at reduced power from offices where ever they can find space, and have started a \$4 million emergency fund to replace this antenna and some of their lost revenue.

During our fall pledge drive, MPR would like to ask our listeners for an additional contribution, one that will go directly to WNYC.

We have been in contact with other public radio stations around the country,

who are also interested in asking their listeners to help WNYC. We anticipate all stations will do this fundraising during the course of their

own on-air fall pledge drives. Most if not all of these stations will be doing their fall pledges drives during October and/or November, 2001.

We therefore respectfully request a waiver from October 18 through October $\ensuremath{\mathsf{October}}$

30, 2001 for MPR to conduct fundraising activities for WNYC. We also request

your assistance in arranging an easy process for other public radio stations to obtain similar waivers.
