Special broadcasting events, community outreach and educational activities for October, November, and December 1997:

- MPR renewed its partnership with the American Composer's Forum and began
  producing programs in *The Composer's Voice* series. In the Fall quarter the monthly
  series featured programs with William Bolcom, Peter Schickele and Philip Glass.
  MPR's Tom Crann hosted these installments.
- CMS hosts Mindy Ratner, Lynne Warfel-Holt, and John Birge broadcast live (9:00 AM 7:00 PM) from downtown Stillwater on December 5, to kick-off CMS' special month of holiday programming.
- As part of the CMS holiday promotional campaign listeners were invited to participate in MPR's Good Tidings competition. The 25 finalists' entries were read on air during MPR's 4 day Christmas Festival (Dec. 22-25).
- The Concordia College Christmas Festival was broadcast on CMS December 18.
- On December 19, MPR aired the Dale Warland Singers Christmas concert, "Echoes of Christmas". MPR also made this production available nationally.
- On December 21, MPR aired Philip Brunelle's Plymouth Music Series Christmas concert, "Welcome Christmas" and made this production nationally available, as well.
- Host John Birge participated in several outreach events with the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, reading children's stories after Saturday morning family concerts.

Special broadcasting events, community outreach and educational activities for April, May, June 1997:

- --To mark Classical Music Month in April, CMS aired the four-part Classical Kids series on Tuesday evenings (April 8, 15, 22, 29 at 7:00 PM): Beethoven Lives Upstairs, Mr. Bach Comes to Call, Tchaikovsky Discovers America, and Vivaldi's Ring of Mystery.
- --On Saturday, April 26, 3:30 PM, CMS broadcast the 1997 Minnesota Music Educator's Association All-State Highlights Concert. Hosted and produced by Mindy Ratner the program featured portions of the band, choir, and orchestra performances recorded in February at Orchestra Hail.
- --On May 1, CMS partnered with the Minnesota Landscape Arboretum in Chanhassen to broadcast a live, May Day celebration from the Arboretum, from 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM. Mindy Ratner, Lynne Warfel-Holt and Eric Friesen hosted their day-parts on location.
- --On June 2, 3, and 4 at 7:00 PM, CMS aired the award-winning series *Out of the Shadows: The Story of Clara Schumann*, written and produced by Stephanie Wendt and Silvester Vicic.
- --CMS broadcast live from the Lake Harriet Bandshell in Minneapolis on Friday, June 20. Eric Friesen was on hand from 4:00-7:00 PM and then Mindy Ratner joined Eric for a 7:00-9:00 PM concert featuring the Minneapolis Pops Orchestra and the Plymouth Festival Singers.

Special broadcasting events, community outreach and educational activities for January, February, March 1997:

- --CMS and the Minnesota Orchestra collaborated on a special outreach event, "At Home with the Minnesota Orchestra". Mark Sheldon and conductor Eiji Oue broadcast live from an extended-care facility in Minneapolis on January 21. Over 200 such facilities around the state participated by listening to the special broadcast.
- --Mark Sheldon was the CMS host speaking at the finals of the High School Music Listening Contest. St. Paul's Harding High School was the winner.
- --CMS celebrated MPR's 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary with a broadcast anniversary program from the Fitzgerald Theater, "Jazz at the Fitz", hosted by Dale Connelly, and Leigh Kamman.
- --During the last two weeks of January, CMS featured the works of composer Franz Schubert, culminating in a 200<sup>th</sup> birthday celebration on January 31. A prominent on-line segment was developed to complement the on-air schedule.
- --In February, CMS noted "Black History Month" with an airing of the program "Classically Black" on February 4, featuring pianist Andre Watts. Brandi Parisi produced an hour-long program highlighting the work of black composers which aired February 18.
- --On March 6 and 13 CMS aired a 2-part series, "Noteworthy Women", featuring the Kronos Quartet, as part of "Women's History Month".
