

Public Notice

On December 8, 1998 Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR") tendered for filing an application with the Federal Communications Commission in Washington DC for authorization to construct a new Class A FM station on channel 209 at Fergus Falls, MN. The proposed facility will operate with an effective radiated power of 2.7 kW. The height of the antenna's radiation center will be 61 meters above ground level. The

transmitter will be located 2 miles north of Fergus Falls, MN, approx intersection of I-94 and US Hwy 59. The applicant has requested a waiver of the Main Studio Rule and the studio will be located at 45 East Seventh Street, Saint Paul, MN 55101. A copy of the application and any amendments or related materials are on file for public inspection at the Fergus Falls public library at 205 East Hampden, Fergus Falls, MN 56537-2194.
