On June 3, 1998 Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR") filed an application with the Federal Communications Commission in Washington DC for Authorization to construct a new Class A FM station on channel 211 at Austin, MN. The proposed facility will operate with an effective radiated power of 6.0 kW. The height of the antenna's radiation center will be 82 meters above ground level. The transmitter will be located 5.1 miles north of Myrtle and 9.12 miles southwest of Austin, MN. The applicant has requested a waiver of the Main Studio Rule and the studio will be located at 206 South Broadway, Suite 735, Rochester, MN 55904.
