This action was taken because a new nearby co-channel full-power station, KJIA FM, Spirit Lake, IA, recently commenced service.

MPR is conducting a frequency search to change the frequency of K205DJ and when a decision is made, MPR will file an application with the Commission to change the frequency of K205DJ. MPR anticipates that K205DJ will be off the air for more than thirty (30) days. Accordingly, MPR requests special temporary authority, for a period of up to twelve (12) months, to remain off the air.
