**Notice of Reduced Power Operation**

Dear Ms. Salas,

Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), by its undersigned attorney and pursuant to Section 73.1560(d) of the Commission's rules, hereby provides notice that the KSJR-FM, Collegeville, Minnesota, transmission site was struck by lightning on June 23, 2000. As a consequence, KSJR-FM is operating at a reduced power of 100 watts, which is below the 90% power minimum specified in Section 73.1560(b) of the Commission's rules. MPR anticipates returning KSJR-FM to full power operation in the very near future.

Should it become necessary, MPR will request Special Temporary Authority to operate KSJR-FM below the 90% power minimum for a period of time longer than 30 days.
