Notice of temporary reduction of operations

Dear Ms Dortch:

In accordance with 47 CFR 74.1263 (c), Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of K297AH, Winona, MN, hereby informs the Commission that MPR temporarily reduced operations of K297AH on January 24, 2003. K297AH rebroadcasts the signal of KZSE FM of Rochester, MN. KZSE-FM is also licensed to MPR. Due to a parts failure that took place on the KZSE facilities on January 24, 2003, KZSE is currently operating on lower power and the signal does not appear to reach K297AH. The replacement part for KZSE-FM is on order and we expect that KZSE will be up to full power shortly, and that consequently K297AH will be back up to full power shortly. A copy of our letter to the Commission regarding the KZSE facility is attached to this letter.

An Anti-Drug Abuse Act certification form is attached. MPR is a noncommercial educational licensee, therefore, no fee is required for this filing.
