Re: Minnesota Public Radio (FRN 0002-6425-10) K297AH, Winona, MN (Facility ID No. 42907) Request for an Special Temporary Operations

Dear Ms Dortch:

By letter filed February 7, 2003, in accordance with 47 CFR 74.1263 (c), Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of K297AH, Winona, MN, informed the Commission that MPR temporarily reduced operations of K297AH on January 24, 2003. Originally this facility was operating at reduced power due to a parts failure at its primary station, KZSE-FM, but that problem has been resolved and K297AH continues to have operational problems. K297AH is currently operating at about 25% of its authorized power. We are not sure exactly what the problem is and therefore cannot immediately resolve the problem, but we are actively working on it and hope to bring this translator back up to full power soon.

MPR therefore anticipates that K297AH will be operating at less than its authorized power for more than thirty (30) days. Accordingly, MPR requests special temporary authority, for a period of up to six (6) months, to continue operations at less than authorized power.

An Anti-Drug Abuse Act certification form is attached. MPR is a noncommercial educational licensee, therefore, no fee is required for this filing.
