On behalf of Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR") and pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.1560(d), this letter is to request special temporary authority to operate WGGL(FM), Houghton, Minnesota, at reduced power. As the Commission was notified by letter dated February 14, 1997, due to structural damage to the station's antenna, WGGL(FM) has been operating at 65% power since February 4, 1997. MPR expects to complete repairs as soon as possible, but in light of the severe winters in the area, repairs may be delayed. Accordingly, MPR respectfully requests temporary authority to continue to operate WGGL(FM) at 65% power for sixty days.
