- I, Thomas J Kigin, hereby declare as follows:
- 1. I am the Executive Vice President and General Counsel of Minnesota Public Radio, the licensee of Station WIRR FM, which is part of a station employment unit based in Buhl, Minnesota and which includes WIRR and WIRN (the "Buhl SEU"). Both stations in this SEU are both licensed to Minnesota Public Radio. This Statement is being submitted in response to the May 28, 2004 letter of Lewis Pulley, Assistant Chief of the Policy Division of the Commission's Media Bureau concerning a random audit of the station's EEO compliance (the "EEO Audit Letter").
